(Continued from Page One) ventilation without a down draft that would blow papers and other records from the desks of the employees. Draperies ordered for the bank will be furnished by Albert Peck and Co. The draperies have been ordered but failed to reach Concord in time for the opening.

Arched transom curtains, of tan mohair easement cloth, will be used. The heading will be Flemish pleated and will be trimmed with heavy bullion fringe, tan and brown colors. Curtains of similar material will be used over the doors and all transoms.

The present home of the bank is double the size of the old quarters, part of the old hotel property being purchased by the bank before the new home was begun. The bank occupies the same location, at the corner of Union and Depot streets.

The completion of the new home of this bank gives Concord three bank buildings that will rank with the best found anywhere. The Citizens Bank and Trust Company and the Cabarrus Savings Bank moved into new homes during the past several years.

KIRK BUS LINES SOLD TO SOUTHERN COACH

Sale Price is Reported to Be \$145,000 Cash—Approved By Corporation Commission. Salisbury, May 27.—According to announcement made today by A. B. Kirk, of Salisbury, the Kirk bus lines, operating between Greensboro and Charlotte, have been sold to the Southern Coach company, of Norfolk. This trade has been on for some time. The reported sale price is \$145,000 cash. It is understood the present schedule will be maintained.

Sale is Given Approval of Corporation Commission. Raleigh, May 27.—Sale of Kirk's Motor Bus Line, Inc., operating between Charlotte and Greensboro, to the Southern Coach company was approved today by the state corporation commission. This gives the Southern Coach company control of all bus service between Charlotte and Greensboro with the exception of a line between Charlotte and Concord.

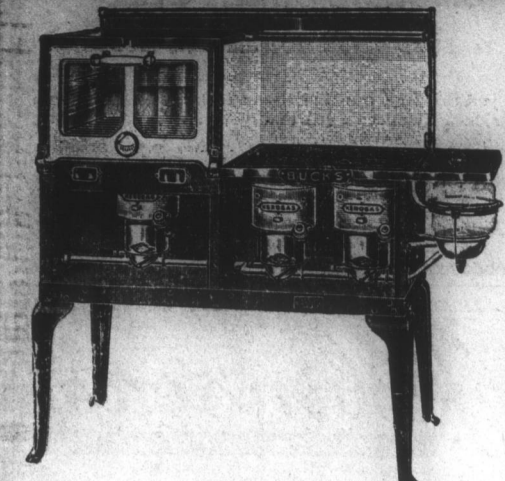
