75 PER CENT THIS YEAR

Every member can get 75 per cent of bankers' valuation if he wants it.

Our Association makes first advance of 50 per cent of bankers' valuation, and the N. C. Agricultural Credit Corporation will loan through local banks one half the first advance (or 25 per cent of bankers' valuation), making 75 per cent right after delivery.

LAST CHANCE FOR "OUTSIDERS"

The Association will accept no new members after opening day in Eastern North Carolina. Outsiders in the Old Belt markets, which are listed above, have until September 17 to sign up, because of previous announcement that these Old Belt markets would not open until September 16. The closing of the membership books applies only to the 1924 crop.
