

Convenient Nests Easy

to Keep in Good Order

Good nests are easy to clean and easy to get at when collecting eggs. They are most convenient to reach when lecated under the dropping boards or on the side walls. Unless the dropping boards are at least four feet from the floor, the nests should not be under them.

There should be one nest for every four birds in the pen. A box 12 by 12 inches in the most aultable size for the average bird. A 1 by 4-inch piece placed about four inches in front of the nests will give the hen a place to step from into the nest. By hinging this strip it can be used to close the nests against pullets in the full and the broody hens in the spring.

The New Jersey experiment station ranks nesting materials in the following order: hay, shavings, sawdust and straw.
