## State Aid.

The legislature has met and adjourned, having declared that the people, representing three different political parties, are opposed to any proposition which will check the progress of education in North Carolia. We recall the wise words of our president, who said at the beginning of the session that he did not for a moment fear the result, when left to the people of North Carolina or their representatives in the Legislature, whatever party might be in power. The words have proved true, and the question of state aid to higher education has met with a solution, the justice of which will never be doubted by the people as a whole, though selfish individuals may from time to time attempt to agitate the matter
Had the Legislature of North Carolina seen fit to withdraw state aid from the University, our state would have stood alone in this great nation as an enemy to civilization and educational progress. But such is not the case and never will be. Such a policy could not be expected or desired by the intellect o our great state. He who would now condemn the action of the Legislature, representing three politica parties and four great religious denominations, must feel that his own opinion is more to be risp cted than the opinion of the people as a whole

A step forward has been taken in giving all extra appropriation to the Normal and Indastrat Selseo ; Gr:nsboro, and the provision two hundred more young ladies to eceive an education should meet with applause from every fire-side in the State.
The committees that visited these institutions were composed of men who were entirely disinterested, many of whom never had a college education. Their report was unbiased by prejudice or self-interest, and found a ready response in the Legislature. We trust that North Carolina's educational policy is forever settled.
