The Crackers Badly Beaten.

Athens, Ga., May 8th.—The two teams reached here at eleven last night having left Atlanta at eight o'clock. Every hospitality is shown the Carolina team up to the time of the game. The grounds and buildings of the University were visited and inspected.

In this game the Georgia players were outplayed at every point from the start, their pitchers batted more than freely and their score very nearly trebled. The game was greatly marred by several unpleasant incidents in the playing of the Georgia team. On several occasions tricks were perpetrated sadly out of keeping with the spirit of amateur sport. The conduct of several of Georgia's players verged at times very closely upon professionalism of the worst type. Here follows the game by innings.

Roger's good coaching was a feature both of the Atlanta and the Athens game.

FIRST INNING.
