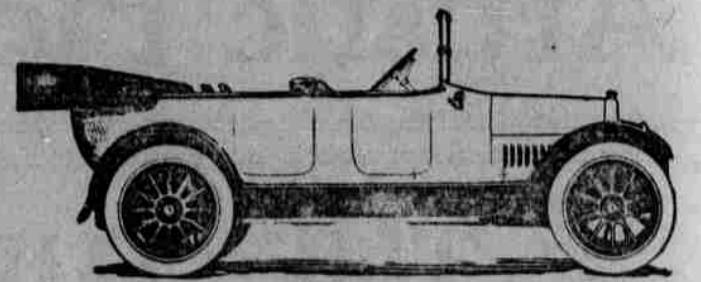

the soles of his shoes are kept sound, and that the uppers are kept thoroughly soaked in some oil.

Another condition which every year interferes seriously with the efficiency of the student body is what is known as "Pink-eye." Dr. Mangum described this as an infection of the membrane which lines the eye lids and covers the front of the eye. He said that it has been pretty well demonstrated that this can in most cases be

prevented by washing out the eye three times a day with boracic acid eye-wash, and by taking care not to use the same wash-basin, towel, handkerchief, or pillow, of anyone who is already infected.

All men who have heretofore been subject to Pink-eye, and all those with any abnormality about their eyes, Dr. Mangum warns to take this precaution at once, for the three cases already in the Infirmary are a mere beginning of the cases usually in college each year heretofore.
