Di, Phi, 'Newcomer' Keep Students Talking

Available to students interested in debating and discussion of topics of interest are three organizations on campus. The two oldest of these are the Assembly of the Philanthropic Society, and the Senate of the Dialectic Society, usually known just as the Di and the Phi. A comparative newcomer to the field is the Carolina Political Union.

The two former organizations are the oldest student organizations on campus. There is a rivalry of a century and a half and more, a rivalry, however, of lignity rather than the all too frequent destructive sort. The meetings of these societies are held in their own meeting halls with that of the Phi being located on the top floor of New East and the Di on the corresponding location in New West. The meetings are conducted in formal fashion in strict accordance with parliamentary law.

The discussions of the CPU are, on the other hand, conducted in a relatively informal atmosphere of a roundtable discussion where members and guests enter on an equal footing.

Representatives of these three groups, together with a representative of the Student Legislature and a presidential appointee compose the Carolina Forum, the branch of the Student Government which is charged with procuring and presenting prominent persons to address the student body. During the past year it presented such speakers as General Mark Clark, Omar Bradley, and Senator Leavertt Saltonstall.

Art Talk By Alcott

John Alcott, head of the University Art Department, will give a gallery talk in Person Hall tomorrow night at 7:30 on the subject "Currents in 20th Century Painting."

Dean Alcott's talk is the first of three such lectures to be given on successive Wednesday nights in connection with the exhibit of European art now on display in the Person Hall Art Gallery. Either a different group of paintings or some special aspect of the exhibition will be discussed in each talk.

The art gallery will be open from 2 to 5 p.m. during the summer months and from 7 to 9 p.m. also on the evenings of the gallery talks.
