Library Notes

The Library here serves more people in a larger variety of ways over a wider area than any other library in the southeast. The Library is the second largest in the southeast and contains more than 700,000 volumes. It houses a number of important collections. One is the Hanes Collection on the History and Development of the Book, the gift of the Hanes family of Winston-Salem. Another is the North Carolina Collection, which was endowed by John Sprunt Hill of Durham who, with his family, also gave the University the Carolina Inn. and Hill hall of music which houses the University's distinguished music department.

The richest collection Southern historical material is in the North Carolina Room of the Library. It is known as the Southern Historical Collection and contains more than three million items assembled during the last quarter of a century by Dr. J. G. deRoulhac Hamilton. It brings to the University the richest storehouse of Southern economic, social, political, cultural and religious source materials in the nation and brings to Chapel Hill research scholars from all over the world.
