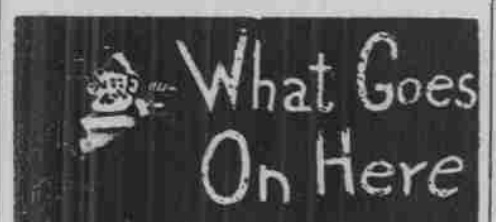

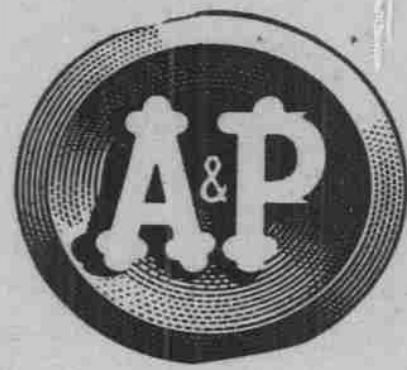
**Presbyterian**
