Elementary teachers and music consultants throughout this and neighboring states are invited to attend the 1953 Summer Workshop in Music Education to be held at the University Monday through next Friday.

Mrs. Adeline McCall, Chapel Hill Music teacher, writer, and director of the educational program for the North Carolina Symphony Orchestra, will be director of the Workshop, which is sponsored by the University Extension Division and approved by the state Department of Public Instruction. Emphasis will be given to music as a part of the whole school program, Mrs. McCall said.

The Workshop is designed to meet the needs of the classroom teacher, the music consultant and the school administrator. "Each will have an opportunity to work with music materials, to exchange experiences, to solve specific problems related to the primary or upper grade curriculum," she said.

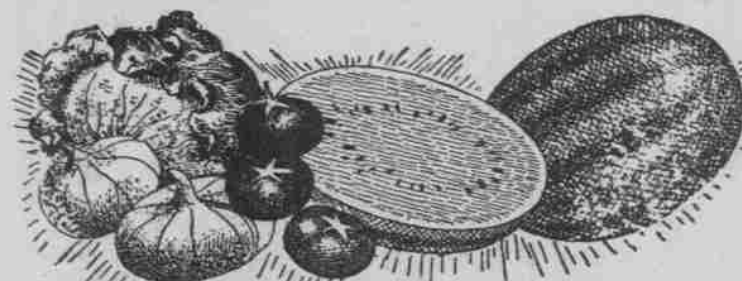

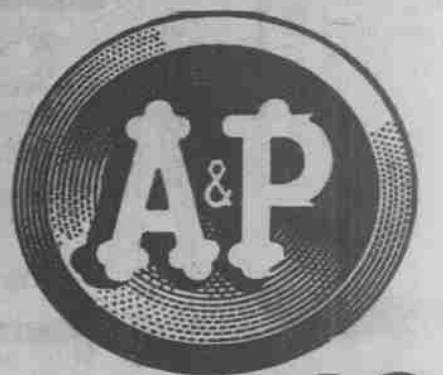
