The examination in Place Geography, required for graduation from the School of Commerce, will be given Friday, November 8 at 2 o'clock in Room 401 New East.

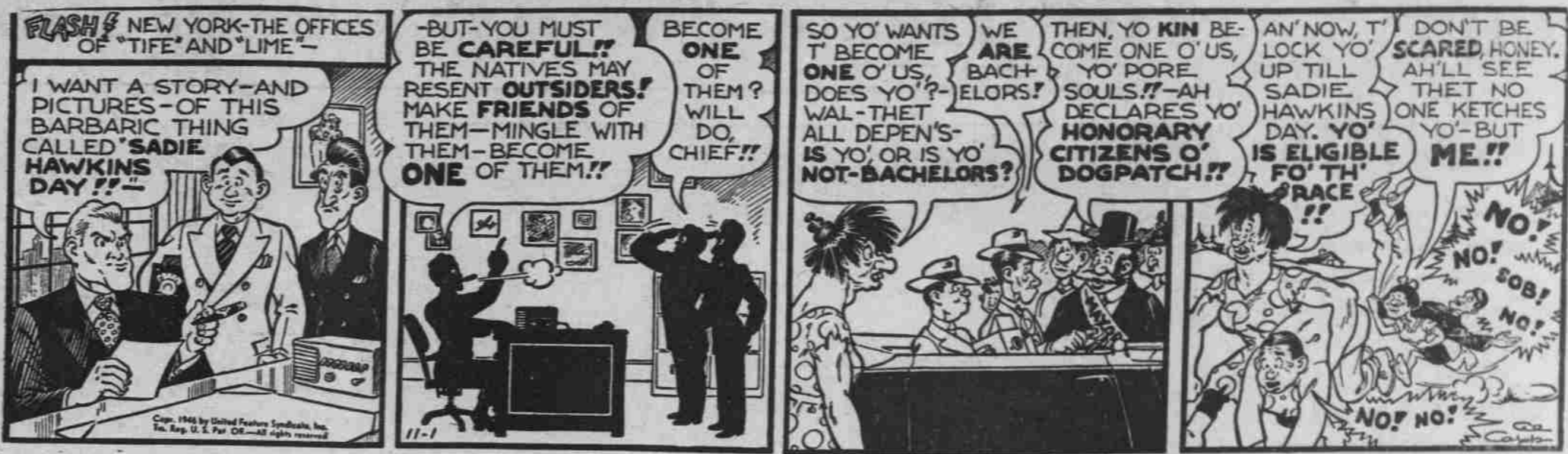

MacNider Named To Research Post

Dr. Wm. deB. MacNider, eminent University pharmacologist and former Dean of the Medical school, has just been appointed by Surgeon General Thomas Parran of the United States Public Health Service as special consultant to the National Institute of Health in the gerontology research section.

Dr. MacNider will be special consultant of research study in the field of gerontology, scientific study of old age.

Purpose of the Society, Dr. MacNider says, is not primarily to study ways of prolonging life but rather to try to ascertain through research check-up methods that will enable human beings to take better care of themselves during middle and old age when troubles often begin to set in.

All members of the instructional staff of the departments of languages

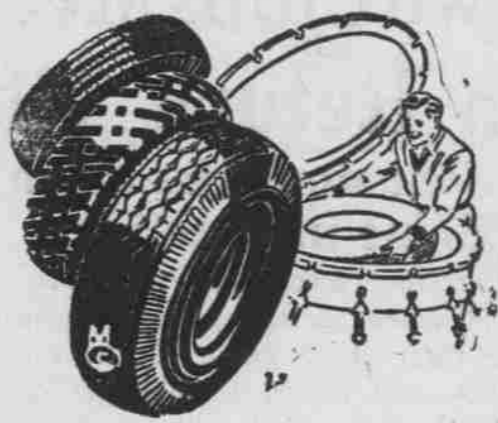
