Satterfield Will Provide Frosh-Soph Hop Music

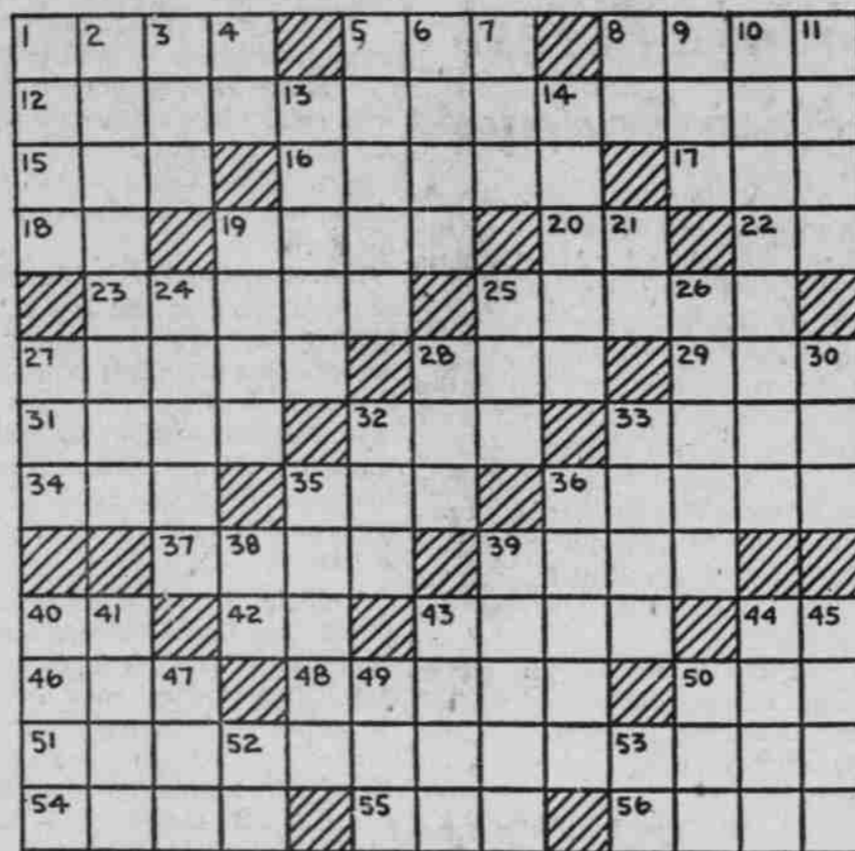
Johnny Satterfield and his 18-piece orchestra will furnish the music for the Freshman and Sophomore dance at Woollen Gym this Saturday night.
