Mrs. Stewart, national president of the United States Section of the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom, will be speaking of the 35th anniversary of the international organization. The Chapel Hill branch of the group is sponsoring the talk.

The United Nations has granted the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom a consultative status B in the Economic and Social Council. This is an unofficial status given non-governmental agencies after investigation. It has also been granted consultative status with UNESCO.
