

### NROTC Major Promoted

Major B. W. McLean, Marine Corps, has been promoted to the rank of lieutenant colonel, Capt. J. E. Cooper, professor of naval science announced yesterday.

Colonel McLean is the Marine officer-instructor at the NROTC unit where he has been stationed since September, 1948. His pro-

motion is effective as of Jan. 1. Colonel McLean reported here from a two-year tour of duty with the First Marine Division in China, after graduation from the Amphibious Warfare School at Quantico, Va. He first entered the Marine Corps in December 1940, receiving his commission as a second lieutenant in June 1941.

### High Honor Is Awarded Dr. Wilson

Another high honor has come to the University and to Dr. Louis R. Wilson, librarian here for 31 years, who has been professor of library science and administration since returning in 1942 from the University of Chicago, where he was dean of the Graduate Library School for 10 years.

Dr. Wilson was one of three new members just elected to honorary membership in the American Library Association, which has conferred this distinction upon only 29 others since it was founded 75 years ago. The election was held at the Association's mid-winter meeting in Chicago and followed a recommendation of the Association's Executive Committee and a unanimous vote of its Council.

Dr. Wilson's name was added to the list "in recognition and appreciation of the distinguished services he has rendered to the Association and the library profession" over a period of half a century, says an announcement from the Association's Executive Secretary, John Mac Kenzie Cory.

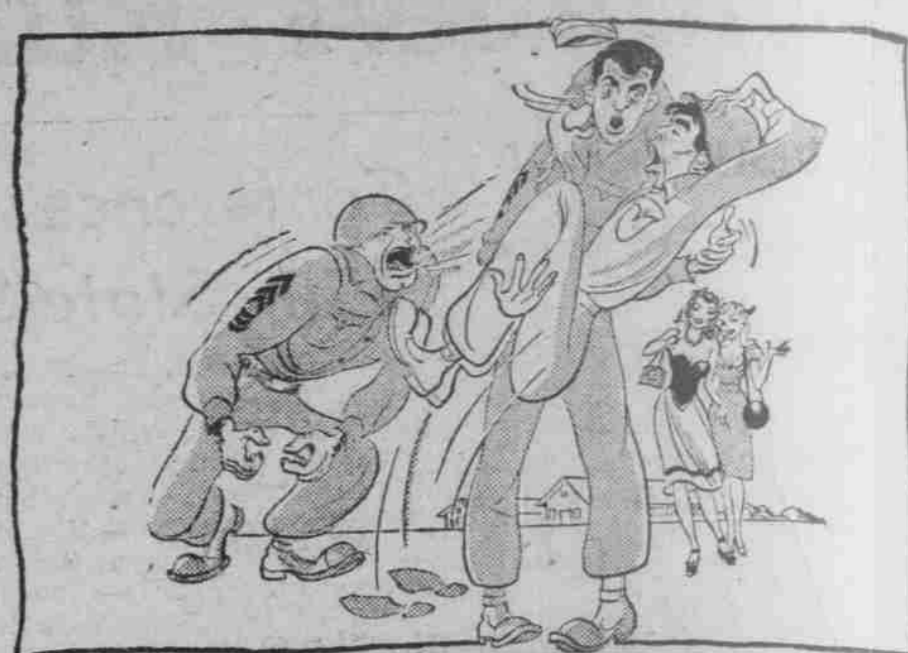
