University Asks Review

RALEIGH, May 23—The U. S. Supreme Court was petitioned today by the State of North Carolina and the University to review the Circuit Court of Appeals decision handed down during winter quarter, ordering that four Negroes be admitted to the Law School.
The petition, prepared by lawyers representing the parties, was mailed Tuesday to the high court to be filed today. It asked for a reconsideration of the decision of the U. S. Circuit Court of Appeals in Richmond.
It stated that such a decision would make it "impossible to have any system of separate law

schools."
The State and University went on to contend that they have "acted in good faith" in attempting to provide separate but equal law schools for whites and Negroes.
