

Frosh Cagers Outclassed 90-63 By Sharp Wake Forest Freshman Five

Winston-Salem — Wake Forest's Baby Deacs, using a devastating fast break to full advantage, completely overwhelmed Carolina's Tar Babies here tonight by 90-63.

appearing a completely different team. The Tar Babies had previously defeated the Deacs twice. But last night it was all Wake Forest from the opening moments.

The Baby Deacs jumped off to an early lead which was never threatened throughout the battle. The Deacs had an early lead of 29-12 and led at half time by 38-23. In the final half they pulled steadily away and the contest was never in doubt.

Big man for Wake Forest was 5' 11" guard Al Hart, who pumped in 28 big points. It was Hart who initiated nearly all of the fast-breaks and continually harassed the Tar Babies with his ball-stealing and trick dribbling tactics. His running mate at guard, Dave Adkins, collected 13 and also stayed in the hair of the Tar Babies all night.

Lou Brown was once again high man for Carolina with 18, but found himself boxed-in whenever he got the ball. A great percentage of Brown's shots were blocked in flight by the alert Wake defenders. Billy Dunlap trailed Brown with 13.

The Tar Babies had two glaring difficulties all night—their inability to work the ball to the inside against the tight Deac zone and their failure to pull down the rebounds. They were forced to shoot from the outside and had trouble finding the range.

The loss tonight lowered Carolina's season record to 9-6, and this is their fourth loss in the last five games.

Scurlock And Bishop Run In New York Sat.

On the boards at the New York AC Indoor Games Saturday, night Tar Heel track fans will find two runners wearing Carolina colors. Dave Scurlock and Wayne Bishop. Scurlock, who has proven to be one of the greatest middle distance runners in Carolina history, will be entered in the "Halpine" half-mile. Bishop, a top distance man in the ACC, will take a try at the 2-mile. Both of these runners have been burning up the indoor boards this season. Scurlock's most recent accomplishment was a first in the Millrose half-mile Saturday, outfoxing some of the best. This plus another first in the Boston AA games earlier in the season has set the scene for Saturday night.

arranged to have what Dale Ranson, Carolina's track coach, calls "the best field Dave will meet this year."

Scurlock, who won with a 1:52.6 last week will be facing: Tom Murphy (Manhattan) who anchored his two-mile relay team in the Millrose in 1:51.1; Ty Hadley (Occidental) who ran a 1:51.1 in the same relay; Joe Soprano (Manhattan) a fine distance man; Zelig Orzwal, Poland's middle distance national champion; and Tom Carroll (Yale) who has finished only a few yards behind Scurlock in the Millrose.

Bishop, who recently added to his collection the "outstanding runner's" award for his performance at the V.M.I. Relays, will be challenging some of the top distance men in the world in the 2-mile. Topping off the list is the number one two-mile in the nation, John Macy, Macy, formerly from Poland, but now running for Houston has clocked 8:57.2 over the distance. Also in the field is Yugoslavia's Velisa Mugosa who has hit 9:03. Bishop's best time is 9:16.
