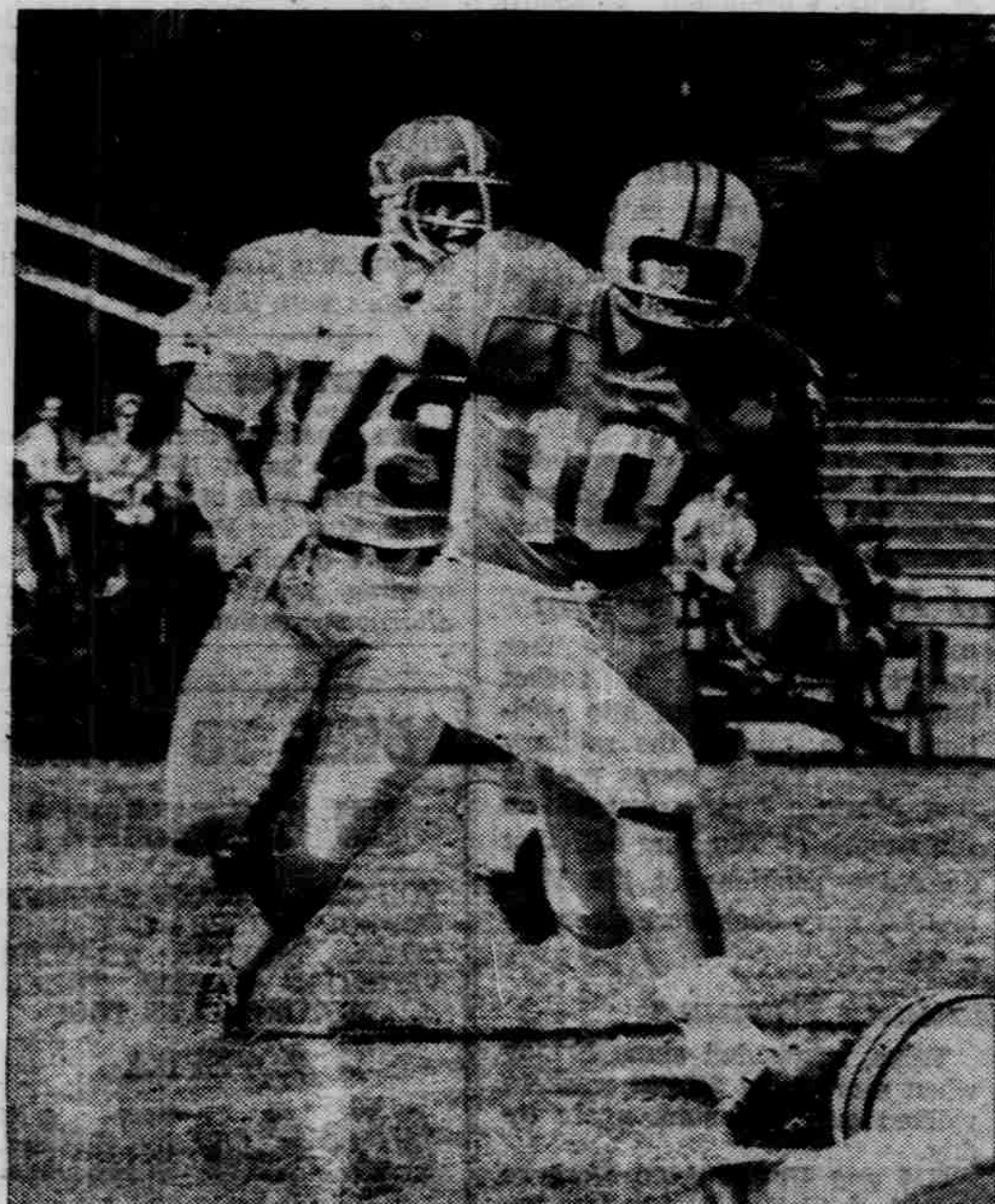

# State Spills Clemson, 9-0

RALEIGH, N. C. (AP)—North Carolina State pounced on Clemson early and threw up a fierce defense Saturday to whip the Tigers 9-0 for the Wolfpack's second straight Atlantic Coast Conference football upset.

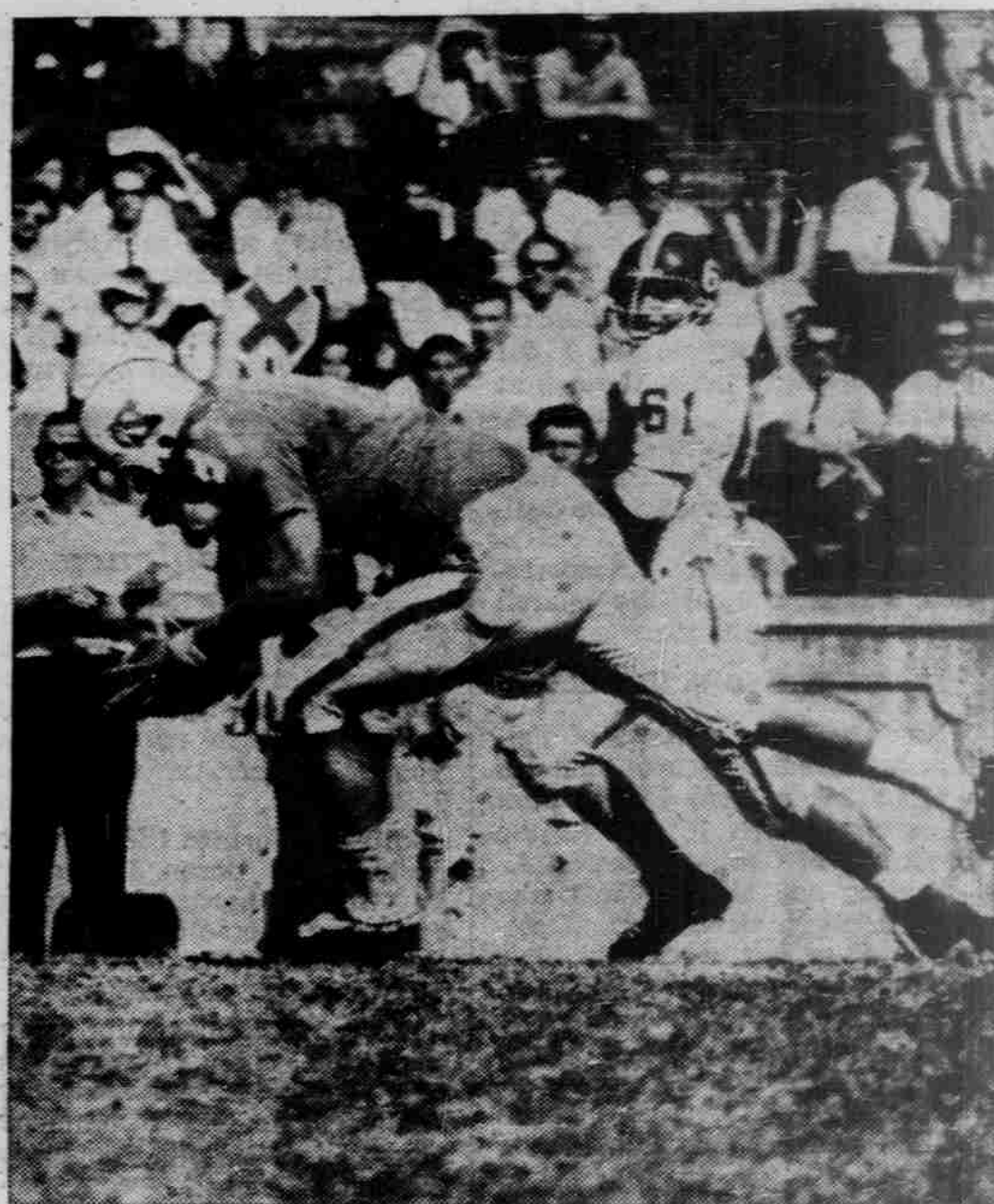
The Wolfpack had a field goal and a touchdown in the first 12 minutes before the small but speedy Tigers could find the right defensive combination.

State then hung on gamely the rest of the way against Clemson's frantic attempts to move the ball.

Halfback Shelby Mansfield provided the spark for the first N. C. State score. The fleet junior carried the opening kickoff from his end zone to the 41 and then broke loose for 32 yards during a drive which bogged down on the Clemson 21.

On fourth down, Harold Deters booted a field goal.

State's touchdown climaxed a 43-yard drive launched when fullback Pete Falzarano stole a Clemson pass on the Wolfpack 30 and returned it to the 43.

# Terp Sophs Crush USC

COLLEGE PARK, Md. (AP)—Maryland's sophomore starring offense and fumble devouring defense, spiced by a Chilean soccer kicker, rolled to a 24-6 football victory Saturday over South Carolina.

The passing of quarterback Phil Petry and running of Tom Hickey, a pair of 18-year-olds, supplied the offensive spark coupled with a field goal and three extra points by specialist Bernardo Branson, on loan from the soccer team.

The alert Terp defense pounced on four fumbles, three of them dropped by fullback Phil Branson, in Maryland's winning start in the Atlantic Coast Conference.

Petry tossed a three-yard touchdown pass to end Howard Humphries and Branson kicked the extra point for a 7-6 Maryland lead in the first half.

# West Virginia Tops Citadel

MORGANTON, W. Va.—(AP)—West Virginia scored the first time it got the ball Saturday and then held on for a shaky 7-3 Southern Conference football victory over The Citadel.

A crowd of 17,000 saw the Mountaineers muff repeated scoring opportunities while picking up their second conference win.

West Virginia drove 47 yards in nine plays for the game's only touchdown. Fullback Dick Leftridge scored it from the three
