For the Duke game Smith dialed a new combination, using Respess, Hassell, and Gauntlett along with Bob and Billy. Those five pulled a stunning upset against the Blue Devils, but then blew a 14point lead in a loss to N. C. State, and next won over Vir-

The seventh combination came against Maryland Saturday. In that game Mirken, who has appeared in all 16 games, got his third starting job along with Johnny Yokley.




