Meschery signs with Cougars

GREENSBORO - Tom Meschery, unorthodox poet and former player in the National Basketball Association, was named head coach of the sagging Carolina Cougars Wednesday by Cougar President Carl Scheer,

The announcement had not been expected for several more days, but Schee: "xid a "premature" story in a state paper Wednesday morning prompted him to release the news "so as not to embarrass any of the other coaches we

had under consideration. The terms and length of the contract

would not be made public until a two years, finally floundering next to the 'get-acquainted news conference" Thursday, according to Scheer.

Meschery, 32, took over the coaching reigns with only 11 days remaining before the Cougars begin practice for the upcoming season.

The Cougars had been without a head coach since August 17 when Jerry Steele, Cougar mentor during the second half of the 1970-71 season, resigned. Steele replaced former Wake Forest coach Bones McKinney, who guided the Cougars since the birth of the team in 1969.

The Cougars, laden with players from Big Four College teams, were unable to find the winning combination their first

Meschery spent five seasons with the San Francisco Warriors where he managed a career-high 16 points per game in 1963 and was rewarded with being selected for the NBA All-Star game. Meschery also managed to continue

writing poetry. He published one collection of his poems, entitled "Over the Rim," with at least two other works scheduled for publication within the next year.


