Templeton and Love

Joan Templeton, a junior chemistry major from Charlotte, and Linda Love, a junior journalism major from Monroe, announced their candidacies for senior class president and vice-president Friday.

The women called for unification of the senior class through changes in graduation ceremonies and a possible class project organized according to suggestions from members of the class.

"Most seniors don't go to graduation and don't care," Templeton said. "We feel like we represent enough organizations on campus to find out what seniors want out of graduation."

"Through our different connections we can find out what the seniors of 1979 want to make graduation special, out-of-the-ordinary," Love said.

Templeton said that before they decided to run for office, she and Love investigated the powers and responsibilities (chiefly organizing graduation) of the offices and the amount of time involved and analyzed their qualifications for the jobs.

Love said she knows of no previous candidates for the offices who were women. Templeton is a Morehead Scholar, a member of the Chancellor's Committee and the Undergraduate Education Committee. She has been a counselor and coordinator of freshman camp and is a member of Delta Delta Delta sorority.

Love is vice president of the University Marching, Concert and Pep Bands and a member of the Society of Janus and Kappa

Mitchell

Pete Mitchell, a junior journalism major, announced his candidacy for Carolina Athletic Association president Sunday.

Mitchell, who is from Lexington, said he would work to make the CAA presidency a more assertive position than it has been in the past.

"I don't think that it's living up to its potential," Mitchell said. "I think that it should cover a wider range of concerns."

Mitchell, who worked for three years as a sports staff writer and columnist for the *Daily Tar Heel*, said that his work in journalism has brought him into contact with many Woollen Gym officials and that he is therefore qualified to handle the CAA post.

Mitchell said the CAA president is in charge of homecoming preparations and that he has some ideas for improving the celebration.

"I think that if the homecoming is going to be held on campus, it should mean something to the students," he said.

"The CAA presidential post is really the students' only voice in athletic affairs," Mitchell said. He said that students need to have more say in matters such as the ticket distribution changes before the Clemson football game last fall.

"I'm very much against the distribution of tickets two weeks in advance. We might want to consider one week ahead, but not two," Mitchell said.

Mitchell said that although the CAA president has not traditionally taken an active part in athletic affairs, the post should at least be able to provide input into decisions made by the athletic department that will affect students.
