Freshman Perkins leads Carolina to 89-74 victory over pesky Mercer

It was the official coming-out party for Sam Perkins, and the only disappointment was that nobody prepared a cake for the occasion.

Perkins and the Tar Heels, back from winning the Great Alaska Shootout on Sunday and looking ahead to the Big Four this weekend, managed an 89-74 win over pesky Mercer Tuesday night in Carmichael Auditorium.

In his first real game before the home crowd, the 6-foot-9 Perkins scored a game-high 22 points, grabbed nine rebounds and collected three blocked shots as North Carolina raised its record to 4-0.

Perkins entered the game with 15:34 left in the first half and the Tar Heels trailing 10-8. He sank two free throws to tie the game, 10-10, and five minutes later he had scored 10 points and Carolina owned a 25-13 lead.

"I seem happiest coming off the bench," Perkins said. "Being a freshman, I don't feel any pressure at all. I just go out the same every night, play hard and play my role."

Perkins had plenty of help from his teammates. Senior Al Wood scored 20 points, sophomore James Worthy had 19 and senior Mike Pepper finished with 10. Jimmy Black finished with eight assists while freshman Matt Doherty had seven.

Carolina shot 73 percent in the first half - 61 percent for the game - but never could take full control. After leading Mercer by as many as 13 points late in the first half, the Bears rallied to cut the halftime margin to eight, 46-38.

"When they started to come back, we'd pick up our game, but we couldn't stretch (the lead) out," Wood

Mercer trimmed Carolina's lead to six points, 56-50, with five minutes elapsed in the second half on a basket by Terry Teague, but the Bears committed two turnovers and never got any closer.

Worthy then hit a 15-foot jump shot and Perkins made a layup off a Doherty assist to boost Carolina's lead to 10 points. Mercer and Carolina traded baskets for the next six minutes, but the Tar Heels used their inside game - particularly baskets from Wood, Worthy and Perkins - to pull away.

"Defensively, we didn't make adjustments quick enough on our zone and they got inside," Mercer coach Bill Bibb said, "That was where they hurt us the most. If I had it to do over, I would play more man-toman. They didn't hurt us man-to-man."

North Carolina coach Dean Smith said he was happy to win but displeased with the Tar Heels' defense. "We didn't play especially well," Smith said. "Our defense left a lot to be desired." They out-hustled us. They're not fun to play."

Six-foot-7 center Benton Wade led Mercer in scoring with 15 points, followed by Tony Gattis with 14 and Teague and Dartez Talbott with 11 each.

"I'm not displeased with the way we played, but we've got some work to do," Bibb said. "Perkins is an outstanding player who gives them a different

Perkins and Doherty played key roles in the Shootout tournament — Perkins was named to the alltournament team - and they continued to be important factors against Mercer.

"Sam and Matt are two freshman you can depend on," Wood said. "They're not ordinary freshmen. They know the game well, and they know the system

Carolina substituted freely, and six players got more than 20 minutes of playing time. Starting center Pete Budko played 17 minutes, and he's still bothered by a stress fracture in his right leg.

Worthy is is still bothered by soreness in his right achilles tendon.

"Once we get 100 percent, with the way everybody is coming on, we'll be able to play with anybody," Wood

Dick Crum wins ACC honor

RALEIGH, (AP)-Dick Crum, who coached North Carolina to a conference championship in football this season, is the 1980 Coach of the Year in the Atlantic Coast Sports Writers Association. The 46-year-old collected 96 of the 122 ballots cast.

Monte Kiffin, in his first season at N.C. State, was second with 13 votes and veteran Jerry Claiborne of Maryland was third with nine votes.

The Tar Heels will meet Texas in the Bluebonnet Bowl on New Year's Eve. Crum has a 3-0 post-season record, having defeated Georgia and South Carolina in the Tangerine Bowl and upsetting Michigan last season in the Gator Bowl.

This is Crum's seventh year as a college head football coach and it's the fourth time one of his teams has won at least 10 games. Crum's team won at least 10 games three times in his four years at Miami of Ohio and now in his third at North Carolina.

His coaching record is 57 victories, 20 defeats and two ties. Six of the losses came in his first year at North Carolina. But Tar Heel followers saw that record of 5-6 improve to 8-3-1 and 10-1.

Before becoming head coach at Miami, Crum was defensive coordinator for the team as the Redskins placed high in the nation on defense each season. Crum has continued to maintain a firm belief in defense and the fundamentals while at Carolina.

His 1980 North Carolina team had two 1,000-yard-plus rushers in Amos Lawrence and Kelvin Bryant. His defensive unit kept six teams from

scoring a touchdown and limited two others to one touchdown each.

Crum is a native of Youngstown, Ohio. After six years as an assistant high school coach, he was head coach at Mentor (Ohio) High School.
