it was something I wanted to do," he said. He plays for the youth choir at Grace AME Zion Church in Charlotte and for various organizations and persons on campus.

Although he doesn't write songs, he takes a music class at Carolina to improve his music technique and theory, he said.

Turner said that he may eventually become involved with activities other than the BSM or the Black Discussion Group, which is headed by Denise Barnes, assistant professor of clinical psychology. But he said he could identify more with black culture groups:

Southern traditions - including the fraternity system - have caused the downfall of CGA's sister organization at the University of Virginia, the Gay Student Union.

Faced with growing opposition from the campus and community, and finding no support from the gay community, the organization will fold after this year.

But Mullis sees a more optimistic future for the CGA. He said he felt gay people here knew they had to be more active because of the climate if they were to survive. He also said he felt that the support of the University, both financial and moral, had kept the organization from

"We have more credibility with students and faculty through outreaches and Gay Awareness Week," he said, "Our core group is committed to expanding the activities of the CGA, and we have so far had the support of the CGC and the UNC administration:"

"I see this University as a pluralistic society. We don't come from different backgrounds and are then melted into an amalgum. We retain a lot of individuality and that's important. What is necessary is an appreciation of those differences and a toleration of them."

Norberg suggested the ordinance be amended to measure the decibel level from 75 feet or the property line, whichever was further away. The council also suggested that the ordinance, when passed, go into effect July 1 instead of immediately upon passage.
