"A couple of beers, and it (the decal) is paid for," Cooley said.

Also, if you wear a Homecoming T-shirt that the Sweet Carolines have been selling this week, you can get the special deal on draft beer. Vicki Hart, a Sweet Caroline, said the T-shirts are long sleeved and Carolina blue, with navy lettering. "Homecoming '81" is on one sleeve, UNC is on the pocket, and a beat Clemson logo is on the back.

The Sweet Carolines are also selling 5000 blue balloons to blocks and individuals. The balloons, which are 5 cents each, are cosponsored by Hardee's (they have been 25 cents each at previous home games).

The balloons for blocks can be ordered from any Sweet Caroline until Friday. They can be picked up Saturday morning before the game at Fetzer gym or the infirmary.

Balloons will also be sold individually on the field before the game.

As the team runs onto the field, the balloons are to be let go all at once.

The Sweet Carolines are also giving away 5000 blue and white free pom poms before the game.

Another group, Granville Residence College, is selling 1000 balloons. These balloons. which will be 25 cents each, will be sold in the Granville cafeteria and in each tower's lobby Saturday morning. Rick Martin, who is on a GRC service committee sponsoring this, said they are selling the balloons to raise money for the United Fund and to raise school spirit.
