# News in Brief

## Snowstorm blasts Midwest

The season's first major snowstorm plastered the Midwest with up to a foot of wind-blown snow Thursday, snapping power lines, sending cars careening into ditches and causing at least two deaths.

"This storm has the potential of being one of the most dangerous that Minnesota has experienced in several years," a forecaster said at the Weather Service in Minneapolis-St. Paul, where 11 inches of snow had accumulated.

An "intense" major storm system centered over southeast Iowa spread across over much of Iowa, North Dakota, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Nebraska and Kansas.

In Minneapolis-St. Paul, the heavy, wet snow toppled trees onto power lines, knocking out power to 30,000 homes. It caused the roof of the new Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome, a stadium being built as the home of the Minnesota Vikings, to sag.

Slippery roads caused numerous traffic accidents across the Midwest.

Two teen-agers were killed when their car collided with another car Wednesday evening on a slushy highway about 10 miles north of Marshall, Minn.

The weather service in Minnesota said that up to 11 inches of snow fell in parts of St. Paul, 9 inches in Young America, 8 inches in Minneapolis, 7 inches in Chaska and 6 inches in Rockford and Stillwater.

In Nebraska, wind speeds were averaging 20 mph to 35 mph, with the Norfolk weather station clocking a blast at 50 mph.
