## Symposium

Pulitzer Prize-winning author to speak tonight on the New Right and evangelism

Prize-winning journalist Frances Fitzgerald will speak as part of the 1982 Carolina Symposium at 7:30 tonight in Memorial Hall.

Fitzgerald, winner of a Pulitzer Prize and a National Book Award for *Fire in the Lake*, an account of the Vietnam War, will speak on new forms of community, particularly the New Right and evangelism.

Before the lecture, Fitzgerald will conduct a workshop in rooms 207 and 209 of the Carolina Union. After the lecture, a reception will be held for Fitzgerald at 9:30 p.m. at the Chi Psi fraternity house.



Also, as part of the Symposium, the film *Ephesus* will be shown from noon to 1 p.m. in room 226 of the Union.

John Sayles' *Return of the Secaucus Seven* kicks off the Union Film Committee's Independent Film Festival tonight at 7:00 and 9:30 in the Union auditorium.
