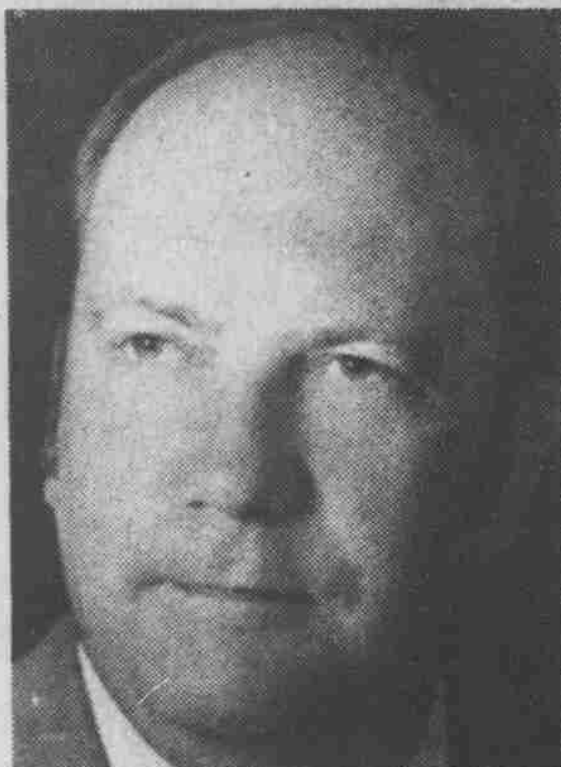


Who's who at Carolina

Therefore, the following is a list of some of the student and administrative offices and the people who hold them:



Donald A. Boulton, vice-chancellor for student affairs — Boulton oversees the Student Health Service, the University Counseling Service, the Carolina Union, the Campus Y, the Department of Student Life and the International Center.



John Drescher, The Daily Tar Heel editor — Drescher, a senior journalism and history major from Raleigh, directs the editorial content of the *DTH* and is in charge of its daily operation.

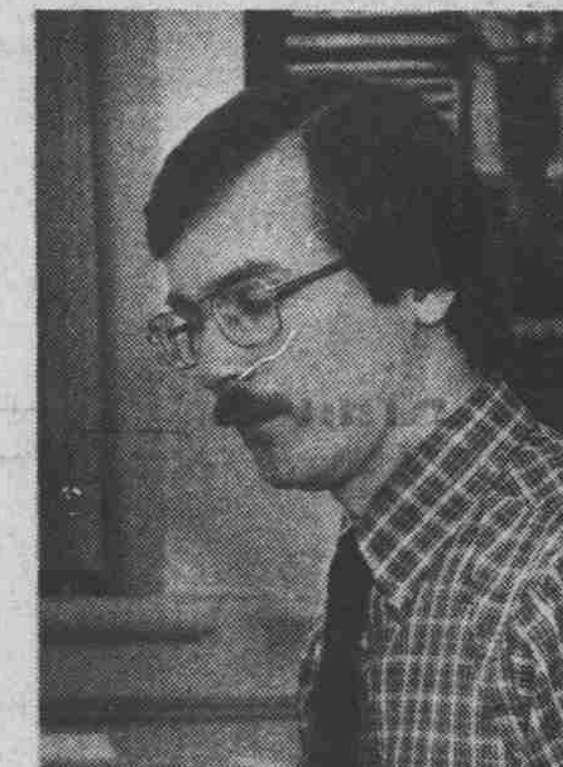
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Christopher C. Fordham III, UNC chancellor — Appointed in January 1980, Fordham supervises the administration of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. His office is in South Building.



William C. Friday, UNC system president — Friday directs the 16-campus UNC system. Appointed in 1964, Friday has his offices in the General Administration building in Chapel Hill.



Jody Harpster, acting director of housing — Harpster became acting housing director July 1, 1982. He oversees the de-

partment of University housing, which is in charge of the residence halls on campus. The search for a permanent housing director will be resumed this spring.



Donald C. Jicha, General College associate dean — Jicha is in charge of the scheduling and registration of freshmen and sophomores.



Bill Kimball, student attorney general — Kimball, a senior from Statesville, investigates charges of Honor Code violations. He heads the attorney general's staff and oversees the Undergraduate Honor Court.



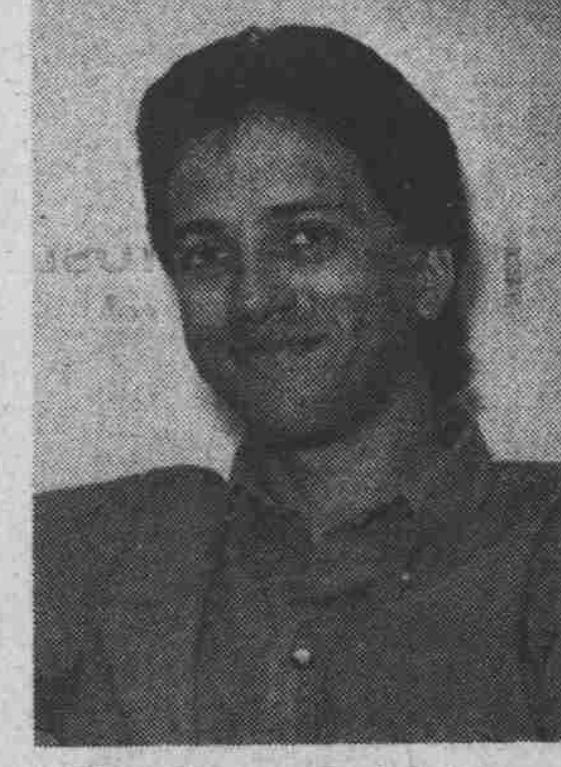
Eleanor Morris, student aid director — Appointed in August 1980, Morris supervises the Student Aid office which awards and distributes financial aid funds.



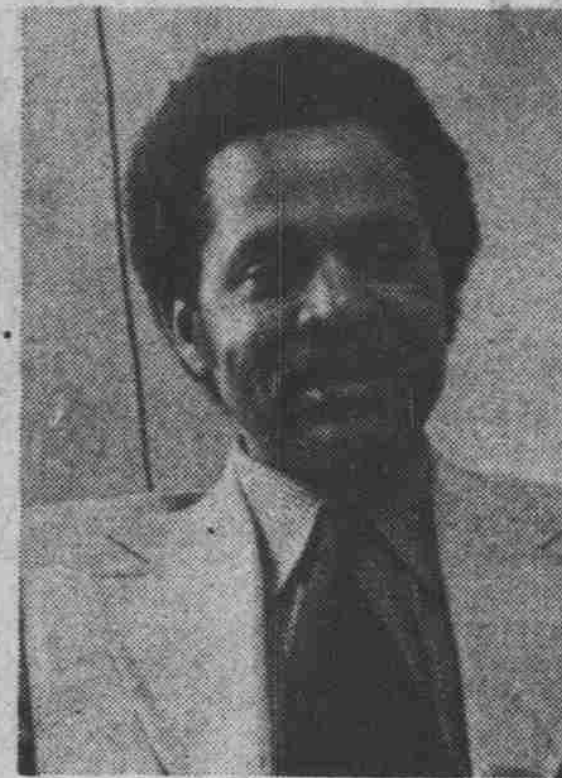
Perry Morrison, Carolina Athletic Association president — Morrison supervises ticket distribution and Homecoming. The Wilson junior also serves as the students' representative for athletics at the University.



J. Charles Morrow, provost — Morrow, appointed in 1968, supervises the administration of Academic Affairs, General College, the College of Arts and Sciences, the University Library, the Ackland Art Museum, the Institute of Government, the Administrative Data Processing Center, six professional schools and the research centers and institutes.



Wayne Plummer, Carolina Union president — Plummer, a senior from Stokesdale, serves as the spokesperson for the Union, and is chairman of the Union Activities Board and the Board of Directors.



Hayden B. Renwick, associate dean of the College of Arts and Sciences — Renwick counsels minority students at the University.



John Swofford, athletic director — Swofford, appointed May 1980, oversees the administration of the varsity sports program at the University.



Scott Templeton, Residence Hall Administration president — Templeton, a senior from Boone, heads the RHA Board and serves as spokesperson for on-campus students.



Mike Vandenberg, student body president — Vandenberg directs the executive branch of student government. His office is in Suite C of the Carolina Union. The Raleigh senior also serves as a member of the Board of Trustees, the General Alumni Board of Directors and the Carolina Union Board.



Bobby Vogler, speaker of the Campus Governing Council — Vogler, a junior from Raleigh, presides over the legislative body of Student Government.



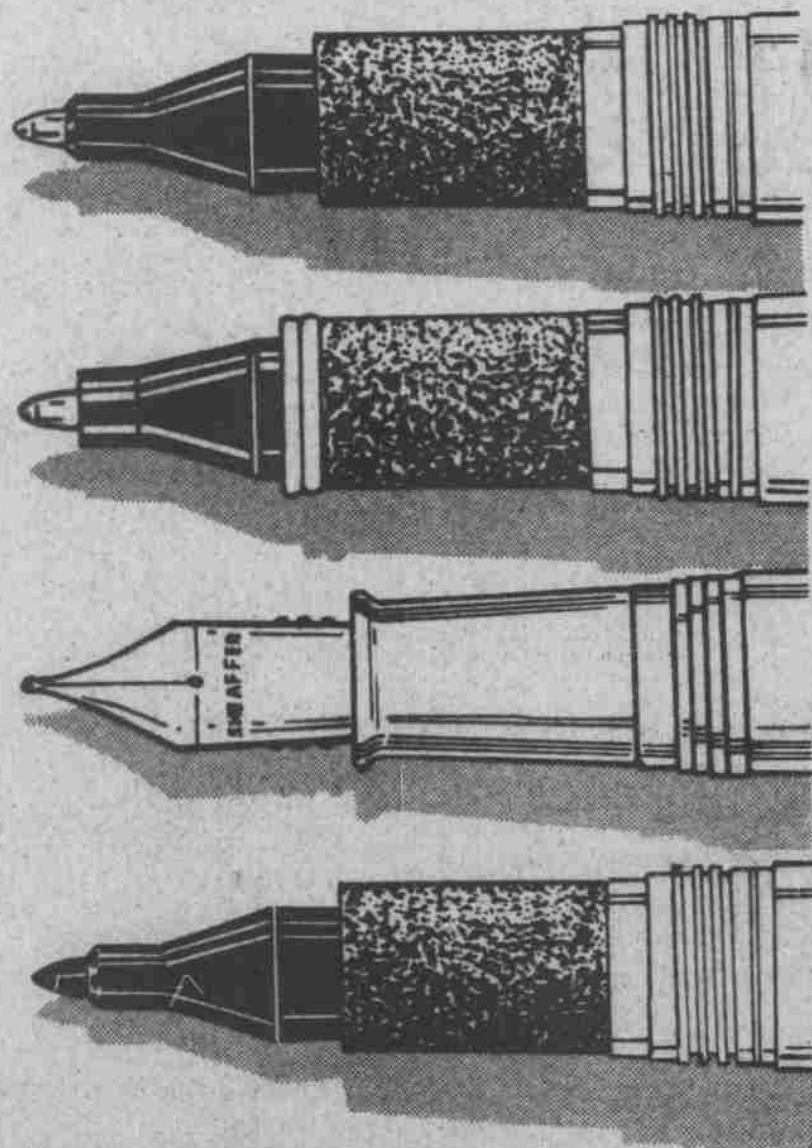
Wendie Watson, Black Student Movement president — Watson heads the Central Committee of the BSM. She is a senior Afro-American Studies major from Durham.



Samuel Williamson, dean of the College of Arts and Sciences and the General College — Williamson oversees the administration of both colleges.

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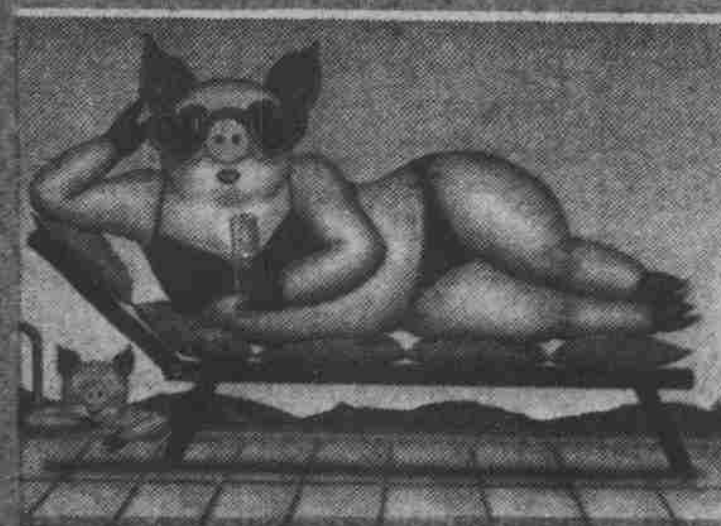
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
