

# Hunt responds to Helms' filing

RALEIGH — Sen. Jesse Helms, R-N.C., should concentrate more on campaign issues and less on attacking potential opponents for his Senate seat, Gov. Jim Hunt said Thursday.

Hunt, expected to declare his candidacy for Helms' seat in February, said at his weekly press conference that he was "disappointed" at comments made by the conservative incumbent after he filed for his third term on Wednesday.

"It came across to me as an attack on me," Hunt said. "I hope that's not typical of the kind of campaign he will run."

Helms accused Hunt, a Democrat, of hiding behind a battery of press aides and refusing to take stands on key issues.

But Hunt responded Thursday that it was Helms who was avoiding the issues.

"What was said that's going to help the people about those jobs that we have to have more of? That's a big issue. People need jobs," Hunt said. "Farmers are in trouble. Farmers home foreclosures on farms in this state are at an all-time record level. They've just cut the heck out of our tobacco program in terms of what we can grow and sell."

Hunt said high interest rates needed to be controlled and that more should be done for the elderly and the schools.

"Those are the problems of real people ... and I think all the candidates ought to be addressing them," he said.

Helms, 62, has opposed abortion and busing to achieve desegregation while backing prayer in public schools. He also advocates a strong national defense and opposed a national holiday honoring slain civil rights leader Martin Luther King Jr.

ACC region and on ESPN elsewhere in the country. This year Raycom planned to produce 38 games for local and regional television and 21 games for Season Ticket. In addition, 13 ACC games are being televised nationally.

"Everyone's intentions with this were good," Swofford said. "We were trying to give viewers who wanted to a chance to see more games."

"We would like to show every game on commercial television, but that's not possible," he added. "We have 38 games on local and regional TV and I think we've reached a saturation point."

Swofford said it was difficult to televise more than 38 games primarily because most television stations were network affiliates and

could preempt only a limited number of regular network programming, especially during prime-time hours when most games were played.

Raycom Vice President Haines said his firm had tried to include a few of the better games in the Season Ticket package to attract more viewers.

Apparently, this marketing strategy was not as successful as Raycom had anticipated. The 70 local cable companies which carried Season Ticket reported earlier in the season that only 1 percent of their cable audiences had subscribed to the service.

Woody Durham, WCHL sports director and long-time UNC sports broadcaster, said he thought the low number of subscribers and

the lawsuits could be attributed to the introduction of the service before ESPN had the capability to offer the games on another channel without interrupting regular ESPN programming.

Swofford added that he thought the athletic directors would consider the reaction of fans and alumni more carefully if a package similar to Season Ticket is ever offered again.

He said that the Season Ticket package grew out of an idea to have a regional ACC sports channel which would include revenue as well as non-revenue sports.

Assistant commissioner Francis said such a channel was a possibility for the future.

**OSLO, Norway — Secretary of State George P. Shultz** vowed Thursday that the United States would maintain its "willpower and self-confidence" while seeking new opportunities for negotiation on arms control with the Soviet Union.

Shultz said at the wind-up of a five-day European trip he had "nothing positive to report" after his five-hour meeting in Stockholm on Wednesday with Soviet Foreign Minister Andrei A. Gromyko on breaking the deadlock in the negotiations.

But Shultz also indicated the Soviets may be getting ready to reopen East-West talks on limiting conventional forces in Europe. These negotiations, called Mutual and Balanced Force Reductions, focus on the troops stationed in Europe by NATO and the Warsaw Pact.

**WASHINGTON — Personal income rose 3.2 percent in 1983** after subtracting taxes and inflation, a six-fold improvement over recession-wracked 1982, the Commerce Department said Thursday.

Both government and private economists said the increase in Americans' disposable income reflected the country's healthy economic recovery in 1983.

but some warned that 1984 won't present so rosy a picture.

The 3.2 percent increase compared to a puny 0.5 percent rise in 1982. Helping the rise was the final round of personal income tax cuts in July and the surge in employment as 4 million more Americans found jobs during the year. Also, incomes were not battered by high inflation. For all of 1983, consumer prices are expected to be up only 3.2 percent.

**BEIRUT, Lebanon — Schools and universities shut down in a rare display** of Moslem-Christian unity Thursday as guns around Beirut were silent as the city mourned the slain president of the American University of Beirut.

Police said investigators had worked up a composite sketch, based on witnesses' descriptions, of one of two men who gunned down Malcolm Kerr as he stepped out of an elevator to his third-floor campus office Wednesday.

In the Akkar region north of Tripoli in Syrian-occupied northern Lebanon, police reported four people killed and 14 wounded in clashes between local militias.

**NEW YORK — Former Sen. Harrison A. Williams Jr., the first senator in 59 years to be convicted of crimes in office,** lost two last-minute court efforts Thursday to delay the start of a three-year sentence for his Abscam conviction.

Only hours after a federal judge declined to stay the start of Williams'

sentence at a Pennsylvania federal prison, a three-judge panel of the 2nd U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals in Manhattan also denied the stay.

"We've considered all the appropriate factors and we are denying the motion," said Judge Wilfred Feinberg, chief judge of the federal appeals court.

**RICHMOND, Va. — The civil rights trial of nine Ku Klux Klansmen and Nazis** meets the criteria outlined by the U.S. Supreme Court for closing jury selection proceedings to the public, a federal appeals court said Thursday.

The 4th Circuit Court of Appeals issued a 17-page opinion explaining its ruling Monday. The court upheld U.S. District Court Judge Thomas Flannery's order barring reporters and the public from his questioning of potential jurors for the Winston-Salem trial.

Lawyers representing eight North Carolina newspapers that challenged the judge's order have filed a petition with the U.S. Supreme Court to have the decision reversed. Chief Justice Warren Burger has yet to rule on the petition.

**NEW YORK — Cotton futures No. 2** closed \$1.25 a bale lower to \$1.25 higher Thursday.

The average price for strict low middling 1 & 1-16 inch spot cotton declined 10 points to 70.97 cents a pound Wednesday for the eight markets, according to the New York Cotton Exchange.
