Carrboro applies for state grant

Carrboro has requested a \$750,000 block grant from the N.C. Department of Natural Resources to revitalize the Lloyd/Broad Street area.

The rehabilitation plans include widening the streets and constructing sidewalks, curbs and gutters, said Roy Williford of the town staff.

He said that \$140,000 would be allocated for low-interest loans for residents in that area.

Applications are judged on the basis of benefit to low- and moderate-income people, project design, community needs and compliance with state policy.

The application submitted by the town last year was turned down, Williford said. Carrboro's project ranked 63rd out of 173 applications submitted.

Duke student wins 10k road race

Bruce Geltman, a graduate business student at Duke University, won the 10-kilometer race in Cross-Country Challenge Saturday at Carmichael field.

The race was one of five events sponsored by WCHL Radio and The News and Observer of Raleigh to raise money for the Chapel Hill-Carrboro Pacers, a running club for children ages 8 to 18.

Between 275 and 300 runners competed in Saturday's races, which included a 100-meter dash and 800-meter race for children, a 2-mile road race, and a 1-mile racewalk.

Pacers volunteer Sue Conrad said the turnout was "a little disappointing" because another racing event was scheduled for the same day.

Second place in the race went to Paul Hefferman, who finished in 35:27. The best female runner was Martha Klopfer at 43:50.

Door prizes will be given out and checks will be accepted. The auctioneers will be Gary Phillips of Weaver Street Realty and Auction and sportscaster Woody Durham.

Joe Roy, a 14-year-old student at Carrington Junior High School in Durham, won the 2-mile event in 11:44. UNC night student Joe Boyle of Chapel Hill finished second at 11:56.

Eric Bingham won the racewalk event in 54:29. Covey was also top female finisher in the racewalk.

Boyd Newman, director of the Pacers, said the club was organized about seven years ago to encourage children to participate in track and field events.

Most of the Pacers' volunteers are parents, but there are also many UNC students who volunteer. The Pacers practice twice a week at Fetzer field.
