

# Reagan

In the 435 House races, Democrats won 102 and led for 106 more, while Republicans had captured 67 and led for 991. It takes 218 for a majority.

The old House lineup was 266 Democrats, 167 Republicans, and two vacancies in seats that had been held by one Democrat and one Republican.

In North Carolina races:

- Democratic Superior Court Judge Lacy Thornburg moved ahead of Allen Foster, a Republican attorney from Greensboro, in the race for attorney general. With 56.8 percent of the vote counted, Thornburg had 53.9 percent to 46.1 percent for Foster.
- In the race for insurance commissioner, Jim Long, a former Democratic state representative and counsel to House Speaker Liston Ramsey, defeated Pinchur Republican Richard T. Morgan. Long had 53.6 percent to 46.4 percent with 1,333 of the precincts counted.
- Secretary of State Thad Eure, 84, beat Republican Patric Dorsey of New Bern 55.7 percent to 44.3 percent, keeping the job he has held 48 years.

With 1,400 of 2,354 precincts reporting, Eure had 697,045 votes to 553,515 for Dorsey.

- Labor Commissioner John Brooks won a third term over Margaret F. Plemmons, a Republican from Winston-Salem leading 54.2 percent to 45.8 percent with 1,305 of 2,354 precincts counted.
- Superintendent of Public Instruction Craig Phillips took an insurmountable 54.8 to 45.2 percent lead over Gere Baker, an elementary school principal from Pikeville in Wayne County. Phillips, en route to re-election, had 606,362 votes with 53.9 percent of the precincts counted while Baker had 499,712.
- Democrat Jim Graham, state agriculture commissioner since 1964, won another term by defeating Republican Leo Tew of Raleigh. With 1,303 precincts reporting, Graham had 58.1 percent to 41.9 percent for Tew.
- State Auditor Ed Renfrow, another Democrat, won a third term against Republican James E. Hicks of Conover. With 57.2 percent of the votes tallied,

Renfrow had 53.9 percent while Hicks had 46.1 percent.

- State Supreme Court Justices Burley Mitchell and Henry Frye fought back from very early deficits and gradually increased their leads with slightly less than half the votes counted. Mitchell led Republican Arthur Donaldson of Salisbury, 52.3 percent to 47.7 percent, and with 1,146 precincts counted, Frye led Republican Clarence C. Boyan 53 percent to 47.7 percent.
