A Harper 32-yard field goal with 4:26 left in the half narrowed North Carolina's lead to 7-6. Fluke touchdown play number two occurred halfway through the third quarter. Duke and North Carolina had taken turns fumbling and punting since the intermission when Tommy Barnhardt went back to punt for UNC at the Duke 45-yard line. His punt bounced at about the 10, apparently hit Duke defensive back Howard Woods in the back, and was downed at the two-yard line by Howard Feggins.

goals by both Harper of Duke and Kenny Miller of UNC, making it 17-9, North Carolina. Miller had missed a field goal in the first half, ending a season-long streak of 15 straight. The North Carolina offense continued to sputter, and UNC punted to Duke with just a minute gone in the fourth quarter. From there Slayden and tailback Stanley Monkled the Blue Devils on an 11-play, 80-yard drive. With a third-and-goal on the UNC eight, Slayden went on a wild goose chase, being pursued by Micah Moon, and lofted a desperation pass from the 20-yard line that hit flanker Gary Frederick wide open for six points. A Slayden pass to Frederick for the two-point conversion and the tie was no good, and it was 17-15.
