needed a weapon with which to cool down Hale.

"Hale was shooting the ball excellently, and we decided to make a change," Cremins said of a move which placed Dairymple on UNC's Kenny Smith. Price opened the game cold but then began popping from the perimeter and beyond to finish with 17 points.

Tech was helped out by the play of a pair of unheralded freshmen, Duane Ferrell and Antoine Ford. Ferrell scored the Jackets' first six points and finished with 11 points and five

rebounds. Ford, meanwhile, managed only six points but made a series of key defensive plays that forced UNC turnovers.

The win moves the Yellow Jackets into a tie with UNC for the ACC lead at 4-2. Tech is 15-3 overall, while UNC falls to 14-4.

UNC has now lost two straight in Carmichael - not only an extreme rarity (UNC is 161-20 at home) — but considered a no-no for a successful conference season.

"Our backs are to the wall," coach

Smith said. "We have a lot of road games left. That's why we need to improve. Maybe we can come back by March and do something spectacular."

UNC has road games at Clemson, N.C. State, Maryland, Duke and Tech.

Hale said it wasn't essential that UNC find a big-play man like Jordan in the meantime but suggested it wouldn't be a detriment to the team. "If you've got five or six men you can go to when they're hot like we have that can be an advantage for you," Hale said. "But if you're one is shooting that well, it can be a disadvantage."
