to make sure people are properly registered in the future. I didn't challenge anything else they did," Poole said.

John F. Hester, supervisor of the Wake County Elections Board, said the Board would begin investigating the incident in five days, the required time to give notice of hearings.

"The Board of Elections will investigate it," Hester said. "We expected it. There'll be some preliminary meetings and hearings by the Board in the next

two weeks."

Hester also declined to identify the commissioner named in the complaint.

The GOP will face more Democratic opposition in the near future, said Ed Turlington, executive director of the N.C. Democratic Party.

"Mr. Poole went to the mall and observed these registration tactics," said Turlington. "It tells me something about the Republicans when they're registering people to vote, they're also asking people to switch their registration."

Turlington said "Democrats Forward" had been created as a task force made up of Democrats from all over the state to get local input into the Democratic Party.

"The task force, proposed by Lt. Gov. Jordan in January, will hold 15 hearings all over the state to see where we need to go and to hear from people at the grassroots level," Turlington said. "The tactics used by Operation Switch and the Helms people will be discussed."





