The Terrapins sent 12 men to the plate when they scored eight runs in the first inning, but Clemson slowly chipped away at the lead with solo runs in the first and second innings and two in the third. Maryland made the score

9-4 in the fifth, but Clemson scored four runs in the bottom of the fifth and two in the sixth to take a 10-9 lead. In the seventh, Maryland regained the lead with three runs, but the Tigers came right back with three in the seventh and four more in the eighth to put the game away. Bert Heffernan went 4-for-6 with a homer and 3 RBIs for the Tigers.

### Georgia Tech 23, N.C. State 11

Buoyed by the home crowd, the Yellow Jackets set tournament records for runs and hits (27) and tournament records were set for combined runs and combined hits. N.C.
