Biker injured in collision with truck

A 19-year-old student was treated for various injuries at North Carolina Memorial Hospital and released after the bike he was riding crashed into a moving cola truck on Main Street in Carborro early Saturday morning.

Brennan Kopp, a sophomore from Asheville, was leaving the parking lot of Wendy's restuarant in Carrboro at approximately 12:30 a.m. Saturday when he pulled into the path of a oncoming truck. Kopp had been visiting a friend on campus and was returning to his residence at Carolina Apartments when he stopped at Wendy's. Finding the restaurant closed, he exited the parking lot and crashed into the truck, which was traveling toward Chapel Hill.

Of the accident itself, Kopp said he remembered nothing. "I remember being in the ambulance," he said.

Most of Kopp's injuries were confined to the face and shoulder areas. The right side of his face is swollen and his right eye is nearly shut. Also his right shoulder is bruised badly, and he has abrasions on his hands.

No charges have been filed in incident, but officials have determined that Kopp failed to yeild right of way to the truck.
