when they have been guilty of genocide against the Indians, enslaving blacks and subjecting them to years of racial discrimination even after banning slavery.

Herzenberg said there were Americans who protested those events when they occurred, so there is no reason not to protest apartheid now.

"I think tyranny is tyranny, and we should speak out against it, whether the tyranny be of the majority, as it was in this country, or of the minority, the white government in South Africa... or whether it is the tyranny of one man in Congress who calls himself our senator."

Joe Straley, a former town council member and an activist for social justice in Central America, said imprisonment is not limited to the isolated arrests of black anti-apartheid leaders. "Literally, all the black people of South Africa are in prison," he said.

"Any time we help maintain a system (such as apartheid), we have become the jailor," Straley said. "We must break that pattern. We must break it as early as we can."

Yonni Chapman, chairman of the Rainbow Coalition Subcommittee on Southern Africa, said the Coalition planned to introduce a resolution to the

town council that would discourage area organizations from doing business with South Africa.

The group collected donations for the South African Council of Churches, an organization which gives the families of prisoners economic support, often for legal expenses.

Bill Thorpe, a member of the Chapel Hill Town Council, said the group had collected \$140 during the vigil and on the streets during the past few days.

"It's not bad. It's a beginning," Thorpe said. "Each of us may feel we are just a flame, but put together, we're a big fire."
