# Duty calls for prospective jurors

The draft has not been in effect for some time, but some people still may be called to duty.

It can strike anywhere, anytime and almost anyone.

Jury duty is something citizens may have to do several times or never in their lifetimes. A random selection process determines the luck of the draw. Anyone between the ages of 18 and 65 is a candidate to serve, but attorneys make the final selection.

Those summoned to serve on a jury receive a letter telling them to appear at a Civil or Supreme Court, depending on the case. At court, the defending and prosecuting attorneys question the prospective jurors.

"The attorneys introduce everyone in the trial and ask the prospective jurors if they know anyone - the defendant, judge, officers or attorneys," said Ben Callahan, Carrboro Police Department officer. "If it is a case involving robbery, they ask if you have ever been robbed or known anyone who has been robbed. The questioning establishes any bias they may have that would affect the trial."

A prospective juror with an opinion about the case cannot serve. In cases involving serious offenses, attorneys ask people if they oppose the death penalty.

"If you have an opinion either way, that knocks you out," Callahan said. "That's why college students generally are not asked to serve in murder cases.'

Certain services are necessary to society, and people holding these jobs - such as doctors, nurses, firemen and policemen - do not have to serve on

The attorneys attempt to select a jury that represents a cross-section of the population, Callahan said. Because attorneys exempt many prospective jurors, the court summons about twice as many people as it needs to serve on a jury. After the attorneys choose 12 jurors and two alternates, the other people summoned leave.

Those chosen must stay until the case is decided. This may take a day, a week or even months. During this time, the jurors receive payment for work compensation and travel costs.

After the two attorneys deliberate the case, the jurors go to a jury room to reach a unanimous verdict. When they do, they elect a foreman, who gives the verdict to the judge. The judge then passes the sentence.

Serving on a jury can be timeconsuming, and not everyone can spare

"I was called, but couldn't go in the middle of the week," said Ray Tingle, a senior from Goldsboro. "I just wrote them a letter and told them I was in

A person called for jury duty who cannot serve must call the court clerk or county sheriff and should send a written excuse to the court. Omitting these steps is regarded as contempt of court and is a felony.

If a person arrives at court and realizes he cannot serve, he or she has one last chance to declare just cause for not serving before the attorneys begin questioning.

Sometimes people don't have to serve because the hearing is cancelled.

"We were getting ready to serve on the jury when all of a sudden the defendant changed his mind," says Barry Mann, a UNC teacher's assistant. "He decided to plead not guilty instead of guilty. It was a murder trial."


