• Get a firm price quotation and estimated time of completion in writing.

• Specify your expectation of an itemized list of parts and labor.

When you pick up your car, review the charges with the mechanic or service manager, the SCAU report said. Keep receipts for future reference.

If you are dissatisfied "immediately return to the shop and explain the problem," the report said. "Most reputable facilities will attempt to work out a mutually agreeable settlement."

If you and your mechanic are not able to come to an agreement, contact SCAU or Student Legal Services.

The SCAU report lists information on 32 shops in the Chapel Hill area. Names of owners, hours of operation, types of services performed, terms of guarantees on labor and parts and labor charges are provided.

Two surveys, one completed by the businesses and another by customers,

provided the information.
