Fuhrmann, Boakes honored

All-American honors for Dave Fuhrmann and Johan Boakes highlighted the Tar Heel's individual performances at the NCAA indoor track championships last weekend in Oklahoma City.

Fuhrmann and Boakes both competed in the 1000 yard running event, and led a contingent of five UNC runners. Fuhrmann, a senior from Port Jefferson, New York, finished

in sixth place with a time of 2:23.62, while Boakes, a freshman from London, England, grabbed the seventh spot with a time of 2:25.55.

Senior Jim Farmer had a strong performance in the 3,000 yard run, finishing sixth in his heat with a 7:58.96 mark. The Raleigh native was not able to qualify for the final in his event, however.

The women's track squad had two freshmen competing in their div-

ision, certainly an encouraging sign for the future of that squad. Mia Pollard continued her excellence in the middle distance running events with a 1:12.57 finish in the 500 yard run, good for fourth place in her heat. She narrowly missed qualifying for the finals.

Wilson native Kim Austin provided the other outstanding freshman performance with a sixth place finish in her heat of the 60 yard high hurdles.

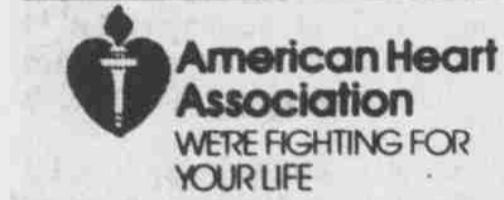
