When asked about specific concerns discussed at the meeting, both Geer and Schroeder said they would not comment beyond the group's released statement. "It's too premature to discuss it," Geer said.

When asked if the group was trying to avoid any of the events surrounding the NCAA championship victory in 1982, Schroeder said, "It was a very pleasant experience everyone here remembers it in a

very positive sense."

The group's press release closed with a statement of support for the Tar Heels on Thursday. "The team plays this Thursday evening, and all of our support and interest should be directed toward that game and succeeding games as they may develop. Go Heels, Beat Notre Dame!"

No plans for festivities in the event of a UNC win Thursday, which would advance the team to the regional finals, were discussed at the meeting, Geer said.

The student organizations represented at the meeting included the Black Student Movement, Student Government, the Residence Hall Association and Greek organizations, according to the statement.

Also, UNC officials representing the Division of Student Affairs, the Athletic Department, the Public Information Office, Facilities Management and University Police attended the meeting.

Representatives from the town of Chapel Hill, including a police spokesman, also attended the meeting.

the task force is to remove the walls separating sections of the first floors of the buildings, allowing passage between the sections without going outside.

Also, the plan called for the development of the space beneath the first floor of one or both buildings, the creation of a weight room exercise space and the addition of laundry and ironing facilities.

The last set of ideas submitted by the task force "allows for academic presence in keeping with early history."

The task force suggested that towers and rooms be named after past important figures in the University's history and that historical displays and pictures be added.

Gillian Cell, dean of the College of Arts and Sciences and the General College, has supported the final proposal, expanding the concept to include making the residence halls into living areas for outstanding seniors.
