But when the football game is over and the open houses are done, there are still plenty of things to do in Chapel Hill. Several entertainment and cultural events scheduled for this weekend should be of interest to both parents and students:

### Friday OCTOBER 6

"Sky Rambles: Tour of the Night Sky," is a live-narrated tour featuring visible planets and constellations with their associated myths at the Morehead Planetarium. The program starts at 7 p.m. Tickets are \$2 each.

The main feature, Morehead Planetarium's second presentation of the evening, "Galaxy," probes the depths of the galaxy and explores the secrets of star cities with some surprising results. Show starts at 8 p.m. Tickets are \$2.50 for students and \$3 for adults.

The North Carolina Symphony will make a special appearance at Memorial Hall at 8 p.m. Tickets are \$18 reserved, \$14 adult general admission and \$12 student general admission at the Union box office.

PlayMakers Repertory Company will present *The Cherry Orchard* by Anton Chekhov in Paul Greene Theater at 8 p.m. Tickets are \$17.50 for adults and \$15 for students. Discounts are available for senior citizens and children under 16. Call 962-1121 for details.

The annual Fall Germans Dance, sponsored by the Alumni Association and Class of 1990, begins at 9 p.m. and features the music of the Casablanca Orchestra in Woollen Gym. Tickets are \$10 for adults and \$5 for students.
