Policemen strike in Nepal to protest deaths of 6 in mob violence

* KATMANDU, Nepal - Hundreds of policemen refused to go to work Tuesday after six of their colleagues were killed in daylong rioting. A Cabinet minister said the army would be used to control any new upsurges of violence.

On Monday, angry mobs beat six policemen to death, and another 15 policemen were reported missing, the
