Athletic Director says Georgia to stay with ACC

From Associated Press reports

ATLANTA - Georgia Tech Athletics Director Homer Rice said Tuesday his school is not thinking about leaving the Atlantic Coast Conference to rejoin the Southeastern Conference.

"We have not been contacted by anyone. We have not sought any contact with any other conference. We are loyal members of the Atlantic coast Conference and we plan to remain that way. We are not entertaining any thought of leaving the Atlantic Coast Conference," Rice said in a

statement Tuesday.

Rice had said previously he would listen if approached by the SEC, from which Tech resigned in 1964.

Football coach Bobby Ross said he feels the same, adding that most Southern football prospects recruited by Tech have "an SEC mentality."

But basketball coach Bobby Cremins was less enthused. "I'm for the ACC," he said. "I'm an ACC man all the way.

"That's one of the reasons I came to Georgia Tech. I really think Tech is embedded in the ACC.

OAKLAND, Calif. - Jose Canseco is close to being the major league's highest paid ballplayer. But he's not yet telling by how much.

The 25-year-old outfielder reached a verbal agreement with the Oakland Athletics on a contract, one that the player's agent on Tuesday said will be the richest in the game.

"You already know the number of years," Canseco said before Oakland 3-2 victory over Detroit Tuesday night. "You'll know the amount tommorow. I can't say any more. You don't want me to get into trouble, do you?"

The team called a news conference for 10 a.m. PDT Wednesday. Sandy

Alderson, Oakland's vice president for baseball operations, confirmed the agreement, but did not specify the contract's length or dollar amount.

"Assuming we sign the contract tommorrow, we are very happy," he said, "But there are some substantial risks involved, something of this magnitude, of this importance, always involves controversy and different view-

points." Rick Thurman of the Beverly Hills Sports Council said the deal was for five years, but also would not disclose the specific amount involved.

Canseco said last Friday that he and the Athletics had agreed on the dollar amount and just needed to work out

minor contract details. When asked if the deal would make him the highestpaid player in the game, Canseco said, "That should be the obvious."

Thurman, reached by telephone at his office on Tuesday, agreed with his client's assessment.

"The contract by far will make him the highest-paid baseball player. It is

the biggest contract there is," he said. The deal enables Canseco to take the distinction as the game's highest-paid player away from Don Mattingly of the New York Yankees, who signed a five-

year, \$19.6 million deal in April. "The A's are happy, Jose is happy and we're happy," Thurman said. A recent newspaper report estimated

the deal to be worth more than \$23 million. Another revealed that Canseco's representatives opened the negotiations by asking for \$20 million over four years and that the A's countered with an offer of \$20 million over five years.

The agreement was reached after more than a month of negotiations, during which Canseco spent 15 days on the disabled list with a back injury.

"The A's dealt in good faith," Thurman said. "I think they really wanted Jose. I know he really wants to

stay in Oakland." "Give him the money," Stewart said. "I'm sure he's happy. A lot of baseball owners will be happy too."


