## Price

Price responded that the state essentially was responsible for educational spending but added that education was important to him.

"I hope we begin to give it the priority it deserves," Price said.

UNC Young Republicans had planned to protest Price's appearance, but the cold weather deterred members from showing up, said Charlton Allen, group chairman.

A press release issued by the Young Republicans said the protest was to be "held in reaction to the insidious poli-

tics practiced by Mr. Price during his terms in the U.S. House of Representatives."

Allen said the Young Republicans disapproved of Price's vote for a congressional pay raise.

"Given the fact that the country is in a recession, we didn't like the idea of the House of Representatives voting itself a pay raise," he said.

Price addressed the issue of pay raises. "The fact is the one pay raise I did vote for was an inclusive package that was designed to get private compensation

out of the system," he said.

"I did not think it was a healthy situation when members of Congress were getting 25 percent of their salaries from private groups."

Price said community meetings were held every few months when Congress was not in session.

"It's a good time for us to meet between the first and second sessions of the 102nd Congress," he said.

Price will be returning to his offices in Washington, D.C., next week.

## Audit

gress last semester, allows all members of congress complete access to the records, he said.

The law states that all records of the executive branch are public records open to any student. The audit board is part of the executive branch.

"What we have is a group trying to claim its bylaws outweigh the constitution of the group that created it," Moore

said.

Daryl Grissom, a task force committee member, said he thought auditing a

few randomly chosen groups a year

instead of every group would be sufficient. "It's like a witch hunt in some ways," he said.


