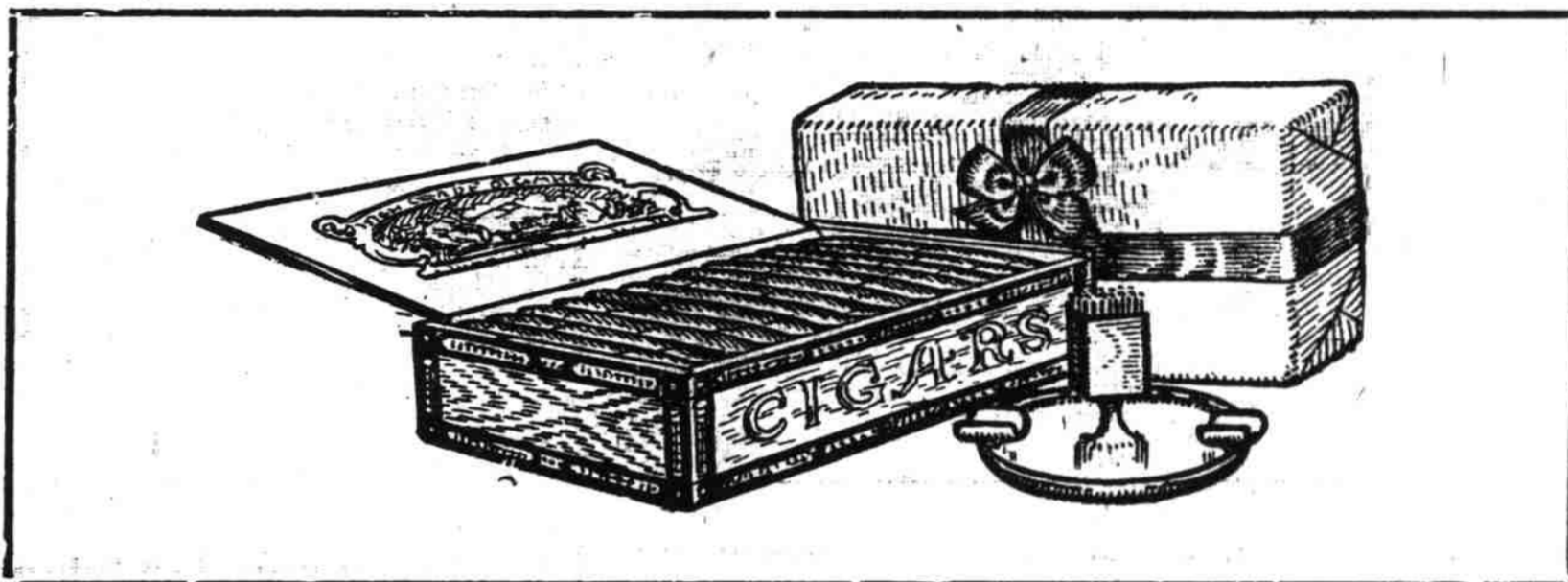

CARDS ARE DISTRIBUTED. Women Launch First Offensive in Campaign Against High Prices. White cards with the following inscription, "Boycott on Eggs, Cheese and Butter. The High Cost of Living Is Driving Us Mad, Read What Is Printed on the Face of This Tag," are being freely distributed about the city. The lettering is done in flaming red ink and a red cord is attached. These cards are attracting no little attention and already the people are commenting. The distribution of the tags is apparently the initial step on the part of the lady organizations of the city following their recent decision to wage an active campaign against what they term unjust and unreasonable prices for the necessities of life. The issuance of the tags, which was preceded by the Housewives' League and the Sorosis going on record as willing to do, without rather than pay the alleged exorbitant prices for the commodities enumerated on the tag is evidence that the ladies of the city intend to carry the war to the last ditch.

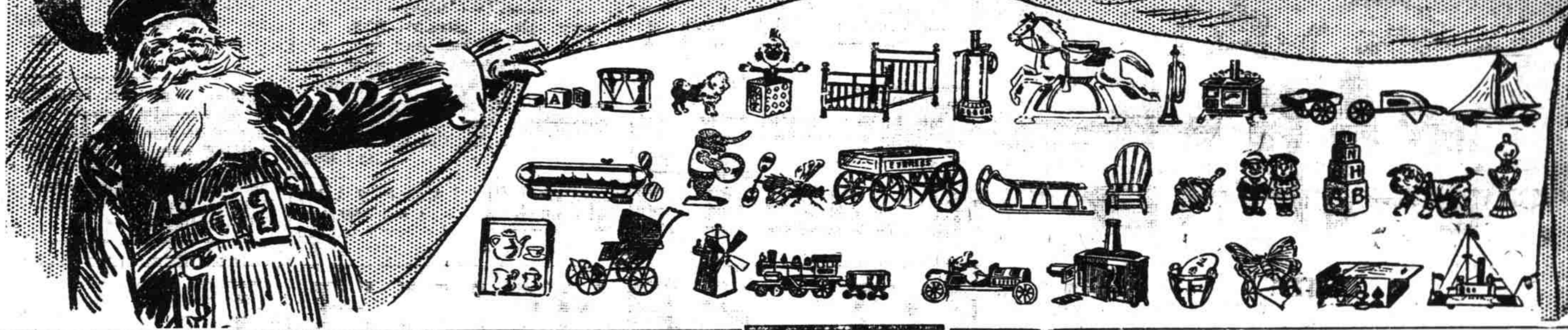
