London, May 14.—The speech on Sunday in which George Nicol Barnes, labor member of the war cabinet, advocated a federal scheme of home rule for the United Kingdom has attracted much attention in political quarters here and in Ireland.

LITHUANIA MUST HELP PAY GERMAN BURDEN

Amsterdam, May 14.—Emperor William has issued a proclamation concerning Lithuania, in which he says it is assumed Lithuania will participate in the war burdens of Germany.

In the proclamation the "independence" of Lithuania, allied with the German empire is recognized. "We assume that the conventions to be concluded," the proclamation says further, "will take the interests of the German empire into account equally with those of Lithuania...
