STEAMER SUNK OFF COAST OF ITALY

New York, June 10.—News of the sinking of the American steamer Mauban off the coast of Italy late in May was brought here today by 26 members of her crew who arrived on a freight steamer.

The Mauban, of 1,253 tons gross register, was built in 1900, and prior to the war was engaged in the Philippine trade. She was last reported leaving Manila for European waters.

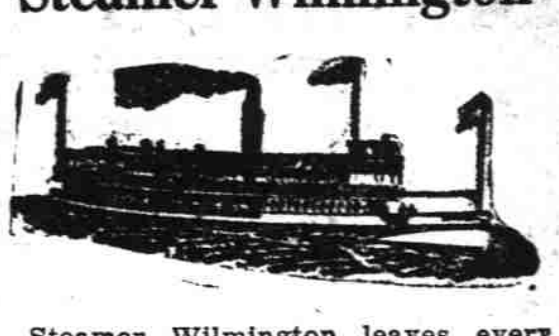
