

State College Hints To Farm Homemakers

How well white shoes survive the summer depends considerably on how they are cleaned, clothing specialists say.

Specialists say clean or polish shoes in the evening, so they will be thoroughly dry for the

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morning's wear and have a firm finish to resist soil. Because moist leather is weak and easily scratched out of shape, liquid cleaner should not be applied to shoes on the feet or just before wearing.

First step in cleaning is to brush off dust, mud, and old, dry cleaner.

The dressing or polish best to use depends on the type of shoes. No one preparation suits all white shoes. The label should tell the kind of leather or fabric on which the preparation is to be used.

Shoes worn without stockings need cleaning inside as well as out, unless protected by socks that fit inside shoes.

State College Answers Timely Farm Questions

Q. How can I prevent aromatic tobacco from being damaged by mold after it has been sun-cured and is hanging in the barn?

A. Roy H. Crouse, extension agronomy specialist, State college, says growers can reduce the chances of molding and barn-scalding by adding some heat to the building during periods of bad weather.

When damp weather occurs, says Mr. Crouse, the heat in buildings housing curing racks should be kept at 90 to 100 degrees. In this way the curing process can be continued in the barn. Curing takes from eight to 12 days under ideal weather conditions.

Q. Dixie Bright 101 tobacco grows with a yellow cast. How can I tell when it is ripe enough to harvest?

A. Most growers of Dixie Bright 101 are harvesting this variety too green, says R. F. Bennett, extension tobacco specialist at State college.

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ripe and mature," he asserts. This lack of maturity, the specialist adds, will show up after the tobacco is cured.

Mr. Bennett suggests that growers allow Dixie Bright 101 to become very ripe—to the extent of almost beginning to fire at the tip of the leaf—before harvest. Then, he says, only two or three leaves per plant should be harvested at a time.


