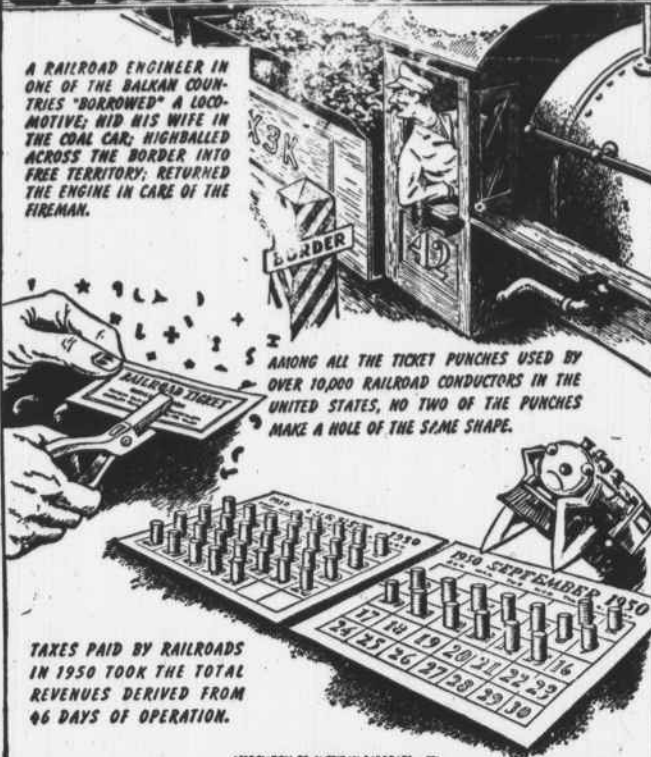


Rail Oddities

The transportation problem includes not only the matter of re-routing busses, due to consolidations, but also the problem of over-crowded busses, he said. More busses probably will be needed, he explained, and he pointed out that original purchases of busses is a county responsibility. "That will take some money", but he added that he didn't believe the people of this county are going to permit children to walk two or three miles for lack of busses.
