SAFETY MAN CLUB SPEAKER
Wilson Says 1,800 N. C. Communities Depend On Trucking

Jeff B. Wilson, director of information and safety of the North Carolina Motor Carriers association, Raleigh, speaking before the Highlands Rotary club last week said, that 1800 communities in North Carolina depends entirely on trucks to bring them everything they eat, wear and use.

Mr. Wilson devoted much of his talk to the three E's of highway safety, engineering, enforcement, and education. He said that in addition to being policed by the state highway patrol, city and county police officers, the trucking industry polices itself, pointing out that the industry has road patrols, company supervisory patrols, and insurance patrols.

He reminded the group that professional truck drivers are trained either under company operation or at the truck drivers training school operated by North Carolina State college. He said that during a recent biennium, truck taxes alone paid 83 per cent of the \$24,000,000 spent by North Carolina for new primary road construction.
