**Wools Make Recovering Furniture Easy Task** — with the "do-it-yourself" craze, the art of recovering simple upholstered furniture has emerged to a large extent from a professional skill to become a routine household task. Women have found that an unsightly chair tucked away in the attic or garage or in plain sight in the living room can be made

usable with a little rebuilding and a pretty new covering. With a few simple instructions, the right tools and materials, the job is an easy one. The first step in approaching the task is the selection of the proper fabrics. The best materials to work with are those firm, strong and not too loosely woven. Because of the ease with which they

may be moulded and draped, many wool fabrics are an ideal choice. Wood fabrics sold for dresses, skirts and as suitings — available in a wide range of textures and colors — are ideally suited to upholstery requirements. Ordinary household cleaning fluids will remove spots or soil from wool fabrics without streaking or leaving rings. **Safety In Closets and Storage Space** — The National Safety Council recommends: (1) storing often-used articles where they can be reached without climbing or over-reaching. (2) providing adequate storage space on ground level if possible for such outdoor items as bicycles, baby buggies,

garden tools, and ladders. Be sure there is good lighting for all storage spaces, and that shelves are strong and within easy reach. **State College Answers Timely Farm Questions** Q. How can I regulate the amount of protein supplement my cattle eat? A. Scientists have found that loose salt with cottonseed meal or meal-grain mixtures can be used to hold daily consumption of protein supplements to the desired level Q. How can I keep birds away from my fruit? A. John H. Harris, in charge of extension horticulture, says that spreading tobacco cloth over the fruit or berries just as they "come into production" is the best system he has found. Q. Is treating soybeans worth the cost? A. Pathologists say it is well worth the cost. It takes only one twenty-fifth of a bushel of soybeans to pay for the material needed to treat enough seed to plant an acre. The treated seed give much better stands and higher yields.

**Dr. Bulgin Passes In Long Beach, Calif.** Dr. Ellwood J. Bulgin, of Long Beach, Calif., died August 13 at his home in Long Beach, after a lingering illness. He was 87 years old. Dr. Bulgin was a brother of Mrs. W. B. McGuire, J. R. Bulgin, and the late G. M. Bulgin, of Franklin. He lived here for a number of years. **Burlington Increasing Production Wages** J. C. Cowan, Jr., vice chairman of the board, has announced that Burlington Industries will increase production wages generally throughout its Southern organization averaging five cents per hour, effective August 22. Mr. Cowan said the company's decision is in keeping with Burlington's policy of sharing with its employees the improvements in the economic conditions of the industry. At the same time, he emphasized that improvement in the textile industry had not kept pace with industry in general. Farmers lose about \$13 billion a year to plant diseases.

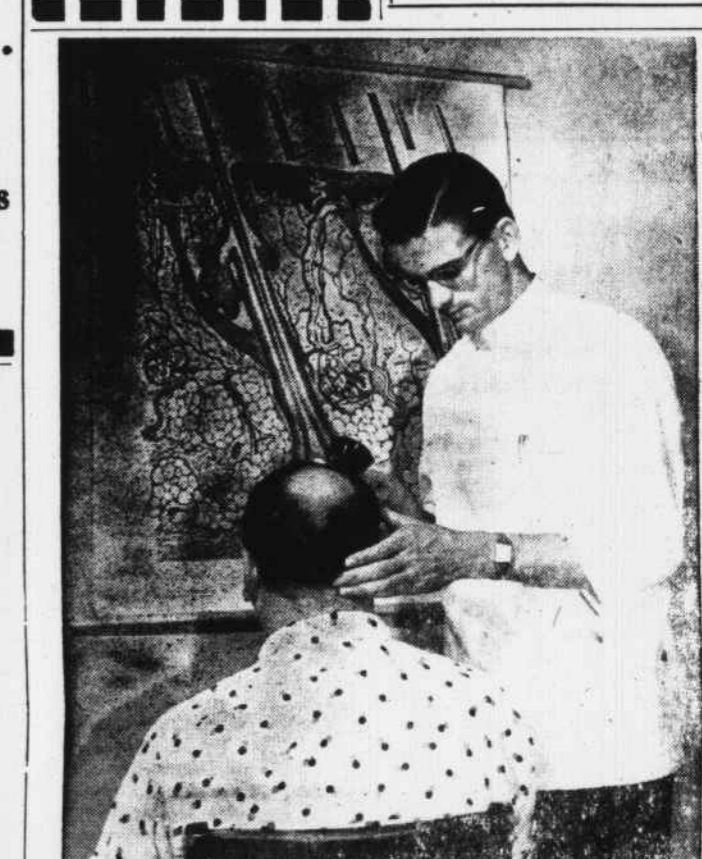
